Chains

- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ \text{S29} \mid \text{S28} \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
- dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 58.60 Wash, course SE., 85 ft. below ridge.
- 68.95 Wash, course E., 30 ft. below previous wash.
- 80.00 25 ft. above wash.
- The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.
- At this point set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{c} \text{T35N} \mid \text{R57E} \\ \text{S29} \mid \text{S28} \\ \hline \text{S32} \mid \text{S33} \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
- dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each section $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
- Land, rolling ridges and shallow ravines with a general SE. slope.
- Soil, dry, medium texture, sandy desert loam, 2nd rate. Too dry for cultivation. Good feed of sagebrush, some grass, weeds and other browse. No timber.
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- S.1°54'W. between secs. 32 and 33.
- Over rolling land, with a general SE. slope.
- 5.00 Low ridge, bears E. and W. Descend gradual S. slope.
- 30.05 Wash, course E., 80 ft. below ridge.
- 40.02 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

- 56.00 Low ridge, bears E. and W., 25 ft. above wash.
- 58.25 Wash, course E., 60 ft. below ridge.
- 66.20 Low ridge, bears E. and W., 60 ft. above wash.
- Descend gradual S. slope.
- 80.04 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, heretofore described.
- Land, rolling ridges and ravines with a general easterly slope.
- Soil, dry, medium texture, sandy desert loam, 2nd rate. Too dry for cultivation. Good feed of sagebrush, some grass, weeds and other feed. No timber.

- dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
