
dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 41.51 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 5.
- 81.71 The cor. for secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33.

FRACTIONAL SUBS. T.35 N., R. 57 E.


N.0°01'E. between secs. 31 and 32.
Ascend over rolling land.

- 40.00 105 ft. above corner; on low ridge bears E. and W.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:




dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 61.96 Wash, course NE., 45 ft. below corner.
- 74.95 Low spur, slopes SE., 70 ft. above wash.
Descend gradual NE. slope.
- 80.00 20 ft. below spur.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd:



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each section $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.
Land, rolling, with a general SE. and easterly slope. Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy and somewhat gravelly desert loam, 2nd rate. Too dry for cultivation. Good feed of sagebrush, some grass and weeds. No timber.

- 40.00 East on a random line between secs. 29 and 32.
Set a temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 84.41 Intersect the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.
Thence West on a true line between secs. 29 and 32.
Ascend over rolling land.
- 7.95 Old road, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.
- 35.10 Small draw, course SE., 55 ft. above corner.
- 42.40 Low spur, slopes SE., 25 ft. above draw.
- 44.41 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 48.00 Wash, course SE., 25 ft. below spur.
- 66.80 Ravine, course SE.
- 84.41 The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, 90 ft. above ravine.
Land, rolling with a slope to the SE.
Soil, dry, medium texture, sandy and somewhat gravelly desert loam, 2nd rate. Too dry for cultivation. Good feed of sagebrush, some grass, weeds and other browse. No timber.
