

Preliminary Field Operations.

- Chains
34 N., R. 59 E., I proceed as follows:
- From the reestablished SW. cor. of Tp. 34 N., R. 60 E., N. $0^{\circ} 07'$ E., on W. bdy. T. 34 N., R. 60 E. just At a point 9.50 chs., set a closing cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N., R. 59 E., hereinafter described. The bearing of the N. bdy. of T. 33 N., R. 59 E., between the old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 2 and 35 and the closing Tp. cor. is therefore N. $86^{\circ} 41'$ W., and the length 133.62 chs.

- Retracement of East Boundary T. 33 N., R. 59 E. For the retracement of E. bdy. T. 33 N., R. 59 E., bet. secs. 31 and 36, see Book of T. 32 N., R. 59 E. From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 on E. bdy. T. 33 N., R. 59 E., I retraced said boundary back east North on E. bdy. bet. secs. 25 and 30. After diligent search I find no trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. - cor. case old measured boundary bounded off.
- After diligent search I find no trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Intersect the old cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, hereinafter described.

- Retracement of the West Boundary T. 33 N., R. 59 E. S.E. I commence at the old cor. of Tp. 33 N., R. 58 E. previously described in Book of T. 32 N., R. 58 E. Thence retrace North on E. Bdy. sec. 36, T. 33 N., R. 58 E. Fall 20 lks. W. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 15x14x4 ins. set loosely in a mound of stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. A rod 10 yds. L to unmarked off. The bearing of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is therefore S. $0^{\circ} 17'$ W., and the length 39.21 chs. L to unmarked off. From this cor. I retrace North on E. Bdy. sec. 36, T. 33 N., R. 58 E. After diligent search I find no trace of the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. Set temp. point. al
