Chains

34 N., R. 59 E., I proceed as follows:

From the reestablished SW. cor. of Tp. 34 N., R. 60 E.,
N. $0^{\circ} 07'$ E., on W. bdy. T. 34 N., R. 60 E.

At a point 9.50 chs., set a closing cor. of Tps. 33 and
34 N., R. 59 E., hereinafter described.

The bearing of the N. bdy. of T. 33 N., R. 59 E., between
the old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 2 and 35 and the closing Tp.
cor. is therefore N. $86^{\circ} 41'$ W., and the length 133.62
chs.

stone, 15x14x4 ins. set loosely in a mound of stone,

mkd. and witnessed as described by the surveyor gene-
