

Retracement of a portion of the Subdivisions
of T. 33 N., R. 60 E.

- Chains I begin at the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the W. bdy. of the twp. described in the notes in connection with the returns of T. 33 N., R. 59 E.
- East on a random line bet. secs. 19 and 30.
- 38.19 Fall 8 lks. N. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. which is a quartzite stone, 8 x 6 x 6 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
- Course of this line is S. 89° 53' E.
- Continue same line.
- 40.13 Intersect N. and S. line 21 lks. N. of the old cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, which is a decayed wood stake showing trace of scribe marks and also trace of pits.
- Course of last half mile is S. 89° 49' E.

- I begin at the old cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, above described, and run
- East on a random line.
- 40.00 I am unable to find any trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. and set temp. cor. and continue line.
- 79.70 Intersect N. and S. line 7 lks. S. of the old cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29 which shows trace of pits and mound of earth, and further identified by being a fence cor. of property lines.
- Course of this mile is N. 89° 57' E.

- North on a random line bet. secs. 20 and 21.
- 40.00 After diligent search, I am unable to find any trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Set temp. cor.
- 79.94 Intersect E. and W. line 46 lks. E. of the old cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, which is a granite stone, 12 x 12 x 8 ins. above ground and a stone mound, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor.
- Course of this mile is N. 0° 20' W.
