47.80 Spur, 170 ft. above draw, projects W.
 53.00 Little draw, 60 ft. below spur, course W.
 55.00 Low spur, 25 ft. above draw, bears NW.
 59.50 Draw, 50 ft. below spur, course S.25°W.
 78.49 The cor. of T.36 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E. described in Group 10.

Land, mountainous.
 Soil is very rocky with many solid outcrops of limestone and quartzite. Soil is decomposed rock of clay, sand and gravel mixed. A little vegetable loam in draws. Timber is juniper and pinon pine. Heavy sage, buck and service berry brush. A little grass.

RETRACEMENT OF N. BDY. T. 36 N., R. 61 E.

June 8, 1915:

At 8 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., at the reestablished corner of Ts. 36 and 37 N., R. 61 E., heretofore described, I set off 41°03'N. on the lat. arc; 22°48'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence West retracing.

40.15 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N. 7 lks. It is a limestone 10x12x10 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of this half mile is N.89°54'W.

80.39 The old cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, bears N. 22 lks. dist. It is a dacite stone 12x10x5 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of the last half mile is N.89°47'W. and the length 40.24 chs.

Beginning at a point 22 lks. South of old sec. cor., West on retracement between secs. 2 and 35.

40.09 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N. 29 lks. It is a dacite stone 8x6x7 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of this half mile is N.89°54'W.

80.30 The old sec. cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, bears N. 32 lks. dist. It is a dacite stone 12x6x14 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of the last half mile is N.89°57'W. and the length 40.21 chs.

Beginning at a point 32 lks. South of old sec. cor., West on a retracement between secs. 3 and 34.

40.21 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N. 38 lks. dist. It is a dacite stone 12x6x6 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

Course of the half mile N.89°55'W.

80.00 The old cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 bears N.63 lks. dist. It is a dacite stone 18x8x6 ins. in a mound of stone, marked as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of the last half mile is N.89°38'W., and the length 39.79 chs.

Beginning at a point 63 lks. South of the old sec. cor., West on a retracement between secs. 4 and 33.

40.12 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. bears N.53 lks. dist. It is a dacite stone 8x6x12 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of this half mile is S.89°51'W.

80.57 The old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 bears N.78 lks.
