


Chains

- 73.10 Main divide between Star and Clover Valleys.
- 82.20 Old road, bears E. and W.
- 82.20 Little draw, 25 ft. below ridge, course NE.
- 91.51 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp., 15.66 chs. N.89°

54' W. of the cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T.37 N., R. 61 E.

At point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2 with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land rolling.

Soil is a mixture of yellow clay, sand and gravel; medium, dry and hard. Very stony. Quartzite and granite stones and boulders. Some aspen timber.

Sage, buck, service berry and choke cherry brush.

A little grass.
