Retracement of West Bdy. T.37 N., R. 62 E.

Chains

- 79.96 The old cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, bears East 53 lks. dist. It is a granite stone 10x6x8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of the last half mile is S.0°10'E., and the length 40.10 chs.
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- 39.79 Continue same line South between secs. 19 and 24.
The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, bears East 74 lks. dist. It is a conglomerate stone 16x12x8 ins. in a mound of stone on cliff, and marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of this half mile is S.0°18'E.
- 79.94 The old cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, bears East 17 lks. It is a granite stone 12x8x10 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of the last half mile is S.0°49'W. and the length 40.15 chs.
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- 40.33 I continue same line South between secs. 25 and 30.
The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 30 bears East 16 lks. dist. It is a limestone 12x10x4 ins., above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of this half mile is S.0°01'W.
May 19, 1915.
May 20, 1915: At a point 16 lks. West of the above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., at 8 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 41°04'N. on the lat. arc; 19°51'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.
Thence continue same line South.
- 80.50 The old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, bears East 17 lks. dist. It is a quartzite stone 8x5x8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of the last half mile is S.0°01'E., and the length 40.17 chs.
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- 40.36 Continue same line South on retracement between secs. 31 and 36.
The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 36, bears East 33 lks. dist. It is a sandstone 20x6x13 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
The course of this half mile is S.0°14'E.
- 80.42 A corner marked for the cor. of four townships bears East 24 lks. dist. It is a basalt stone 10x6x8 ins. above ground, with 6 notches on each edge, T37N on NE. face; R62E on SE.; T36N on SW., and R61E on NW. face, with a mound of stone to the west.
The course of the last half mile is S.0°08'W., and the length 40.06 chs.
- 12.89 I now continue South from the above corner.
The original corner of Ts. 36 and 37 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., heretofore described, bears East 5.77 chs.
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The old stone corners on the above retraced line being in good condition, I leave them as found for the secs. west of line, and resurvey for secs. East of line, making the secs. 80 chs. long as referred to South Bdy.
