Chains

- 22.90 Head of draw, course N.15°E.
 26.52 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. 35 ft. above spur, which I leave for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25, only.
 Thence S.0°01'E. over broken W. slope of mountain.
 31.20 Small patch of mahogany trees about 5 chs. E. of line.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 30, with brass cap mkd:

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
 66.69 The old sec. cor., which I leave for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, only. 75 ft. below former old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Thence S.0°14'E.
 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
 Land, rolling W. slope of mountain.
 Soil is very rocky with many outcrops of limestone and basalt. Many boulders. On and among rocks is friable clay and sand with a little gravel. No outcrops at S. end of mile but many boulders. At South end, cold, heavy, red clay with a little gravel. Sagebrush and good grass.
 No timber.

- S.0°14'E. on a resurvey along the W. Bdy. of sec. 31. Over rolling W. slope of mountain through heavy service berry, scrub sagebrush, Buffalo Clover and good grass.
 27.05 The old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which I leave for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only. 35 ft. below former old sec. cor. Thence S.0°08'W.
 31.70 Enter scrub cedar timber, bears E. and W.
 36.70 Spur of ridge, 65 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., projects W.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 31, with brass cap mkd:

- 51.70 Old wood road, bears N.70°W. and S.70°E.
 67.11 Old Tp. Cor., which I reestablish as follows:
 Alongside of rock, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 4 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the cor. of Tps. 36 and 37 N., Rg. 61 E., with brass cap mkd:
