

## Chains

59.70 Clover Valley road, bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.  
 81.45 The old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, heretofore described, which I reestablish as follows:  
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each section 5½ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.  
 Land, rolling E. slope.  
 West 40 chs. heavy, cold, clay soil with a little gravel. Scattering quartzite boulders. To east, gradually changing to sandy loam with no rocks. No timber. Heavy sagebrush. Some grass.

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 RETRACEMENT OF SUBDIVISIONS T.37 N., R.62 E.
 

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May 21, 1915:

At the reestablished cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the South Bdy. of the Tp., heretofore described, I set off 41°03'N. on the lat. arc; 20°04'N. on the decl. arc; and at 9 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., determine a meridian with the solar.

40.00 Thence N. on a retracement between secs. 34 and 35. The old ¼ sec. cor. bears N.74°24'E. 2.80 chs. It is an old cedar stake 2x2x24 ins., standing in an old mound of stone, and marked ¼S on W. face. The course of this half mile is N.3°47'E., and the length 40.84 chs.

From the above old cor., I continue North on retracement. Begin measurement from the old ¼ sec. cor.

39.91 The old cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, bears West 2.30 chs. dist. It is a badly decayed wooden post 2x2x24 ins. lying on an old mound of stone. The course of the last half mile is N.3°18'W., and the length 39.98 chs.

39.45 Continue same line North on retracement between secs. 26 and 27. I measure from a point 2.30 chs. East of old sec. cor. The old ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 27, bears W. 236 lks. dist. It is an old pine stake 1x1x30 ins, mkd. ¼S, lying on an old mound of earth. The course of this half mile is N.0°05'W. I continue North on same line.

78.89 The old cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, bears West 2.42 chs. dist. It is an old mound of stone. No post found. The course of the last half mile is N.0°05'W., and the length 39.44 chs.

At this cor., I set off 41°05'N. on the lat. arc; and observe the sun on the meridian at apparent noon, the resulting declination is 20°5½'N.

40.22 Continue North from the old corner on a retracement between secs. 22 and 23. The old ¼ sec. cor. bears West 5 lks. dist. It is an old stake 2x2x30 ins. marked ¼S lying on an old mound of earth.
