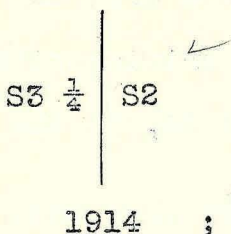


Subdivisions of T. 29 N.R. 40E.

Chains

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 2 & 3 with brass cap mkd.;

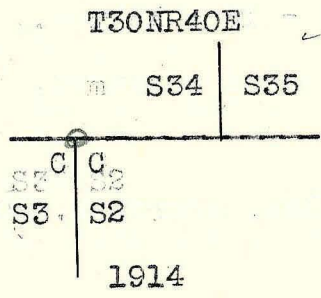


and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
Gradually ascend 86 ft. to wash,

61.50 Dry wash, 40 lks. wide, 40 ft. deep, course S. 70° E., descend gradually 12 ft. to the township boundary.

79.93 Intersect the north boundary of the township 106 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 34 & 35, T. 30 N., R. 40 E., heretofore heretofore described. At the point of intersection I set a cor. as follows;

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bed rock, in a mound of stone, for the closing cor. of secs. 2 & 3, with brass cap mkd.;



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, gently rolling east slope valley.
Soil, stony and rocky clay loam, wash from foot hills;
3d. rate.
Undergrowth, sage and desert brush, bunch grass.
No timber.
