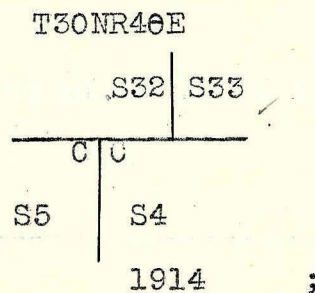


## Subdivisions of T. 29 N., R. 40 E.

Chains

69.10 To base of granite cliffs, bearing N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; ascend over granite ledges 299 ft. to the north boundary of the Township.

80.08 Intersect the north boundary of the township, 1.16 chs. W. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 30 N., R. 40 E. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows; Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.;



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, rough mountains.

Soil, light clay loam, rocky, shale slide rock and decomposed granite.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunch grass.

No timber.

Mountainous land, 80.08 chs.

Aug. 27, 1914

Surveyed by A.T. Harris.

Aug. 26, 1914: At 8h. 15m., a.m., l.m.t.; I set off 40° 20' N. on the lat. arc; 10° 35' N. on the decl. arc; and determined a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the south boundary of the township.

Thence I run

N. 00° 9' W. bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over mountainous land ascend 199 ft.

13.60 To top of ridge, bears S. 60° W. and N. 60° E.; ascend a long west slope of ridge 57 ft.
