

Subdivisions of T. 29 N., R. 40 E.

Chains.

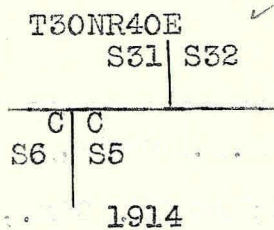
55.00 To bottom of gulch, course west; ascend 104 ft.

61.50 To top of spur, bears E. and W.; descend 407 ft.

75.00 To bottom of gulch, course west; ascend 37 ft. to the township boundary.

79.93 Intersect the north boundary of the township, 6.64 chs. W. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 30 N., R. 40 E., heretofore described. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows;

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and on a mound of stone for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd;



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, slide rock and barren outcroppings.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunch grass.

No timber

Mountainous land, 79.93 chs.
