

Resurvey of the East Boundary of T. 30 N., R. 40 E.

Chains

Undergrowth, sage and desert brush, bunch grass.
No timber.

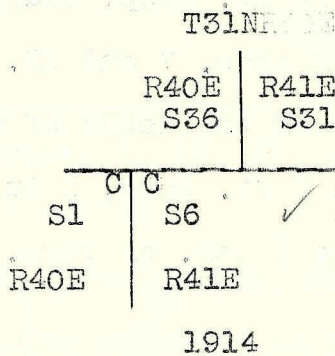
From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, I retrace North bet. secs. 1 and 6.

39.94 Intersect E. and W. line, 6 lks. w. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of se
secs. 1 and 6, which is a willow stake, 1-2-30 ins. long
set 6 ins. in the ground, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S. and witnessed by
pits and mound of earth.
Course, N. 0° 5' E.

I continue my retracement north along same line.

79.75 Intersect the north boundary of the township 19 lks. west
of pits and mound of earth, with willow post, 2-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ -30
ins. long, lying alongside. The post is mkd. S1 and S6,
CC. I reestablish the cor. at the center of the mound
of earth as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 6, T. 30 N.,
Rs. 40 and 41 E., with brass cap mkd.;



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S.
of cor.

The course of the last $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is N. 00° 11' E. and the
distance is 39.81, therefore I run
S. 00° 11' W. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Over slightly rolling valley land sloping east; gradually
ascend 104 ft. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

2.10 Dry wash, 4 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S. 75° E.

9.00 Wagon road, bears N. 20° W. for 5 chs., thence N.E. and
S. 30° E.

19.50 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S. 65° E.
