

## Resurvey of portion of subdivisions of T. 30 N., R. 40 E.

Chains.

Retracement by A.T.Harris.

Sept. 2, 1914: At 10h. 30m., a.m., l.m.t., I set off  $40^{\circ} 25'$  N. on the lat. arc;  $8^{\circ} 3'$  N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on the south boundary of the township, previously described in the field notes of T. 29 N., R. 40 E.

Thence I retrace,

North bet. secs. 31 and 32.

40.00 Set temp. point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 31 and 32, after diligent search no traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. are found. I continue my retracement north along same line.

80.00 Set a temp. point for the old cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. At this point I make adiligent search of 3 hours for the old cor., but can find no traces or evidence of the old cor.

Sept. 2, 1914

Retracement by A.T.Harris.

Sept. 3, 1914: At 9h. 00m. a.m., l.m.t., I set off  $40^{\circ} 26'$  N. on the lat. arc;  $7^{\circ} 43'$  N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the point for the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Thence I retrace

North bet. secs. 29 and 30

40.00 Set temp. point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 29 and 30. No traces of the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. are found after diligent search, therefore I continue my retracement north along same line, setting temp. points at intervals of 40.00 chs. and making careful search for the old cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 20, and the old cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20, of which I find no traces or evidence, and at,

160.00 Set a temp. point for the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20 at the close of the days work.
