Chains

W. of cor.


Descend 30 ft.

43.50 To bottom of canyon, course S. 60° E., ascend.

52.32 Top of ridge, 135 ft. above bottom of canyon, bears
N. 45° W. and S. 45° E.; ascend over rolling land
ascend 65 ft. to the township boundary.

79.45 Intersect the north boundary of the township, 15.85 chs.
W. of the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, of T. 31 N.,
R. 40 E. At the point of intersection I build a cor.
as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, with brass
cap. mkd.:
