

Subdivisions of T. 31 N., R. 40 E.


Chains

Over mountainous land, descend abrupt slope.

7.70 Top of spur, 180 ft. below sec. cor., bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; descend along west slope.

36.80 Cross ravine, 850 ft. below top of spur, course east; ascend 50 ft. to the sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{2}$ cor. of secs. 13 and 14, with brass cap mkd.:




and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

45.50 Top of low spur, 205 ft. above ravine, bears S. 75° E. and N. 75° W.; descend.

51.80 Gulch, 130 ft. below top of spur, course S. 60° E.; ascend abrupt slope 700 ft. to the sec. cor.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, with brass cap mkd.:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous

Soil, rocky clay loam, slide rock and barren ledges.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunch grass.

No timber.

Land, suitable for grazing.

East on a blank line bet. secs. 12 and 13.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.08 Intersect the east boundary of the township, 73 lks. S. 0° 04' W. of the cor. of secs. 7 and 18, of T. 31 N.,
