


Subdivisions of T. 31 N., R. 40 E.

Chains.

71.90 Top of spur, 295 ft. below summit of ridge, bears N. 35° E. and S. 35° W.; descend N.W. slope 145 ft. to the sec. cor.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, with brass cap mkd.:

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay loam, slide rock and barren outcropping ledges of limestone.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, mountain laurel and bunch grass.

No timber.


Land, suitable for grazing purposes.

East on a blank line bet. secs. 1 and 12.

40.00 Set temp, ¼ sec. cor.

79.90 Intersect the east boundary of the township, 68 lks. S. 0° 02' E. of the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, of T. 31 N. R. 41 E. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:-
