Chains

21.98 Bottom of dry wash, 40 lks. wide,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. deep, 105 ft. below sec. cor., course N.  $40^\circ$  W.; ascend along north slope of spur 140 ft. to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

Descend gradually 265 ft. to the closing cor.

79.97 Intersect the west boundary of the township, 1.96 chs. N.  $0^\circ 01'$  W. of the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, of T. 31 N., R. 39 E. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:-

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.:



dig pits, 24x 18 x 12 ins., crosswise on each line, N. and S. of cor. 3 ft., and E. of cor. 7 ft. dist.; and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, E. of cor.
