


Subdivisions of T. 31 N., R. 40 E.

Chains

the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

13.80 Cross Pleasant Valley and Golconda wagon road, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{2}$ cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.:




and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Ascend.

73.30 Top of low rocky ridge, 515 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., bears N. and S.; descend 145 ft. to the closing cor.

79.90 Intersect the west boundary of the township 1.96 chs. N. $0^\circ 01'$ W. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, of T. 31 N., R. 39E. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:-

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap mkd.:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.
