Chains

Surveyed by H.W.Reppert:-

Oct. 8, 1914: For solar on this date, see bet. secs. 17 & 18

Knowing that the line bet. secs. 5 and 6 will not close on

the cor. of secstr 31 and 32 of T. 32 N., R. 40 E., with

in 21' of arc., I run

N. 0° 01' W. on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.

Over slightly rolling valley land, descend 115 ft. to the

$\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

32.99 Cross dry wash, 20 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, course N. 40° W.

38.98 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course N. 45° W.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.:

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Descend gradually 125 ft. to the township boundary.

79.25 Intersect the north boundary of the township 63 lks. N. at 88° 10' E. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32 of T. 32 N., R. 40 E. At the point of intersection I build a cor. as follows:-

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.:
