 S. 89° 59'E. bet. secs. 1 and 36.
 Over mountainous land. Ascend 10 ft. on NW. slope.
 4.00 Top of ascent; descend 25 ft. on E. slope to gulch.
 7.60 Gulch, course N. 15° E. but coming from S. 15°E.; ascend
 40 ft. on W. slope.
 20.00 Top of ascent, leave mountains enter rolling land N. and
 S.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
 the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap marked

 72.00 Top of ascent; thence along N. slope to corner.
 80.00 The cor. of Ts. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 21 and 22 E. herein-
 before described.
 The W. 20 chs. and the E. 28 chs. of this mile consist of
 mountainous land. The remainder is rolling. The
 entire mile is drained toward the north. The soil is
 very rocky and unfit for cultivation. There is a fair
 growth of sagebrush and of bunchgrass. No timber.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 39 N., R. 21 EAST.

The S. bdy. of this Tp. being defective in alignment, I
 subdivide the Tp. from N. to S. and E. to W. I proceed
 as follows:

September 10: At 10h. 0m. a.m., l.m.t., I set off 41°
 18' on the lat. arc and 5° 5' N. on the decl. arc and
 determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs.
 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the N. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore
 described.

Thence I run

S. 0° 1'E., between secs. 1 and 2.

Over mountainous land. Ascend 145 ft. to top of ridge
 starting on NW. slope.

32.15 Road, Denio ranch to Eagleville, Calif., bears N. 30°W.
 and S. 30°E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in
 the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

48.00 Slope changes to NE.

52.20 Ridge, bears E. and W.; descend 85 ft. on SE slope to
 draw.

64.00 Draw, course S. 75°E.; ascend 25 ft. on NE slope to
 corner. The road is 5 chs. distant from the line at
 this point.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in
 the ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, with
 brass cap mkd.
