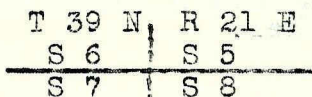


Chains

61.90 Draw, course S. 60°W.; ascend 30 ft. on NW. slope to top of spur.
 68.60 Low spur, projects S. 60°W.; descend 20 ft. on SW. slope to cor.
 80.00 Foot of descent.
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, with brass cap marked

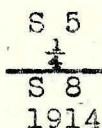

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.

This mile is on rolling land, sloping to the SW. The soil is sandy and gravelly with a good depth and produces a good growth of sagebrush. No timber.

40.00 S. 89° 59'E. on a random line bet. secs. 5 and 8.
 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.
 80.10 Intersect N. and S. line 23 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
 Thence I run
 N. 89° 49'W. on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 8.
 Over rolling land. Descend 130 ft. on SW. slope to ravine.
 17.60 Ravine, course S.; ascend 30 ft. on SE. slope.
 40.05 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor.

44.00 Top of ascent; descend 55 ft. on W. slope to wash.
 57.10 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S. 30°W.; ascend 10 ft. on SE. slope.
 68.00 Top of ascent; descend 65 ft. on SW. slope to corner.
 80.10 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.
 This mile is on rolling land sloping SW. The soil is sandy and gravelly and produces a heavy growth of sagebrush. No timber.

40.00 N. 89° 59'W. on a random line bet. secs. 6 and 7.
 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor.
 79.13 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 19 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 12 ins. above ground marked and witnessed as described in my field notes of surveys included in group No. 12.
 Thence I run
 N. 89° 53'E., on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.
 Over rolling land.
 35.00 Low spur, projects NW.
 39.13 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
