Land, nearly level.
Soil, adobe.
Low grease wood and shad scale. No timber.

July 23, 1915.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 30 N., R. 22 EAST

July 17: At 7h.45m., a.m., 1.m.t., I set off 40° 24.5' on the lat. arc and 21° 20' N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the tp., hereinbefore described.

Thence I run N. 0° 1' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36

Along gentle E. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

54.60 New road, little traveled, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.

78.10 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N. E.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.,

Land, gentle E. slope.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and stony.

Fair grease wood, shad scale and sage brush. No timber.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.04 Intersect the East bdy. of the tp. 2 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, hereinbefore described,

Thence I run

N. 89° 59' W., on a true line, bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Ascend very gradually on E. slope.

40.02 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
