

Subdivision of T. 30 N., R. 22 E.

Chains	
57.00	Top of high rocky point, sloping in all directions. Descend 200 ft. on N. E. slope to wash.
70.70	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S. 70°E.; ascend 90 ft. on S. E. slope.
86.00	Top of ascent; descend 95 ft. on N. E. slope to Closing Corner.
102.24	Intersect the Sixth Standard Parallel N., R. 22 E., at a point 4.13 chs. East of the Standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the S. bdy. of sec. 34 and at the point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 2 and 3, with a brass cap mkd.,

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and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of corner.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, stony, gravelly and rocky.

Vegetation, low sagebrush and shadscale. No timber.

At this Closing Corner, I set off 19° 34' N. on the decl. arc and at about 12h. 6m., p.m., 1.m.t., I observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 40° 30'.

July 26, 1915.

June 22: From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore described, I run N. 0° 2' W., bet. secs. 33 and 34. Over mountainous land. Descend 430 ft. on N. W. slope to creek.

16.75 Rodeo Creek, 80 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, slight flow of water, course N. 80°E.; ascend 1000 ft. starting on S.E. slope.

17.20 Road to Bonham claim, bears N. 80°E. and S. 80°W.

35.00 Slope changes to S.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of corner.

This corner is on a very steep S. slope with much shale slide rock.

45.00 Slope changes to S. E.

63.00 Top of ascent; descend 160 ft. on N. E. slope to draw.

75.50 Draw, course S. 85°E.; ascend 60 ft. on S. E. slope to corner.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd.,
