The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18
The E. 45 chs. of this mile consists of rolling land, with a gentle E. slope. The remainder is rough. The soil of the rolling portion is sandy loam, gravelly and rocky. That of the rougher portion is very rocky. There is a fair growth of sagebrush and bunchgrass on the entire mile. No timber.

West, on a true line, bet. secs. 7 and 18.
Over mountainous land. Descend 10 ft. on SW. slope to draw.

- 12.50 Draw, course S.70°E.; ascend 230 ft. to top of ridge, starting on NE. slope.
- 22.00 Slope changes to E.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

and raise amount of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of corner.

- 50.00 Ridge, bears N. and S., descend 75 ft. on SW. slope.
- 70.00 Foot of descent; ascend 30 ft. on SE. slope to top of ridge.
- 76.00 Low rocky ridge, bears N. and S. descend 355 ft. on NW. slope to draw.
- 109.60 Draw, course N.; ascend 240 ft. to cor., starting on E. slope.
- 155.00 Divide bet. High Rock and Little High Rock Creeks, bears NW. and SE.; slope changes to SE.
- 173.77 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 39 N., R. 22 E. at a point 4.00 chs. North of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on E. bdy. sec. 1 and at pt. of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for CC of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap marked

- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 21 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked
