- 45.50 of cor. Spur, projects NE.; descend 510 ft. on N. slope to brook.
- 78.60 Brook, flowing, clear water, 5 lks. wide, 5 ins. deep, course N. 80°E.; ascend 50 ft. on SE. slope to cor.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, with brass cap mkd.;





and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, gravelly, stony and rocky.
Low sagebrush and fair grass.
No timber.

North, bet. secs. 7 and 12.

- 5.00 Over mountainous land, Ascend 105 ft. on SE. slope to top of spur.
- 12.90 Spur, projects E.; descend 200 ft. on NE. slope to creek.
- 24.50 Donnelly Creek, flowing, clear water, 5 lks. wide, 5 ins. deep, course S. 75°E.; ascend 365 ft. on SE. slope to summit of knoll.
- 34.00 Summit of knoll; descend 35 ft. on NW. slope to draw.
- 39.50 Draw, course E.; ascend 40 ft. on S. slope.
- 40.00 Top of ascent; descend 5 ft. on N. slope.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 18 ins. in the ground, to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 41.00 Foot of descent; ascend 515 ft. on SE. slope to top of ridge
- 49.70 Wash, 5 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S. 60°E.
- 71.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.; descend 125 ft. on NE. slope to cor.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 5 ins. in the ground, to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.;

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. This corner is on a very rocky point, projecting NE.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, bad land, stony and rocky.
Low sagebrush and shadscale. Fair bunch grass.
No timber.
At this cor. I set off 22°43'N. on the decl. arc and at about 11h.58m., a.m., 1.m.t., observe the sun on meridian. Resulting latitude 41° 8'.

North, between secs. 1 and 6.

- 8.90 Over mountainous land. Descend 130 ft. on NE. slope to ravine.
- 28.50 Ravine, course S. 75°E.; ascend 385 ft. on steep and rocky S. slope.
- 36.00 Top of ascent; descend 30 ft. on NE. slope.
- 40.00 Foot of descent; ascend 10 ft. on S. slope.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 4 ins. in the ground, to solid rock and in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;
