

Resurvey of Subdivision Lines of T. 37 N., R. 25 E.

Chains.

Scattered greasewood.
No timber.
May 22, 1915.

May 21: From the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, here-
inbefore described, I run
S. 0° 17' W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.
Over gently undulating land.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.:

Traveling at noon; observation for latitude, impossible.
May 21, 1915.

SUBDIVISION OF T. 37 N., R. 25 E.

May 29: At 8h 10m a.m., l.m.t., set off 41° 3.5' on lat.
arc and 21° 32' N. on decl. arc, and determine meridian
with the solar at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on
the S. bdy. of the Tp. hereinbefore described.

Thence, I run
N. 0° 1' E., bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Over mountainous land.
Descend 200 ft. on NE. slope to brook.
Brook, slightly flowing, in ravine, course E.; ascend
200 ft. on S. slope to top of ridge.

Ridge, bears N. 85° W. and S. 85° E.; descend 170 ft. on
N. slope to ravine.

37.05

Ravine, bears N. 80° E.; ascend 90 ft. on SE. slope to
top of spur.

40.00

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.:

Ravine, bears S. 85° E.; ascend 200 ft. on S. slope to
cor.

the ground, for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with
