

Resurvey of South Boundary T. 15 N., R. 24 E.

Chains

chs., and to SW. on remaining portion of mile. Soil, loose sandy, sandy and gravelly loams and stony; 2nd to 3rd rates. Undergrowth, short sagebrush, shadscale and grass. No timber. Grazing land.

N. 89° 52'W., resurveying bet. secs. 6 and 31. Over rolling and hilly land, facing SW. Base of ridge, bears N. and S.; ascend steep E. rocky face.

Top of spur ledge, 105 ft. above sec. cor., projects S.20°W., 3 chs. and N.20°E., 3 chs. to top.

Descend rocky slope, 120 ft. Ravine, at base of hill, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course N. 20°W. thence over rolling plain, slight slope to the N.

Ravine, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course NE.

60 ft. below sec. cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

From this point the old ¼ cor. bears N., 12 lks. dist. I place the marked stone alongside of iron post, and destroy all traces of the original site of cor.

The cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 N., Rs. 23 and 24 E., which is a porphyry stone 8x10x16 ins., loosely set in small mound of stone, properly marked, I reestablish cor. as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 10 ins. in the ground, to underlying rock, and in a mound of stone, for cor. of Tps. 14 and 15 N., Rs. 23 and 24 E., with brass cap mkd.,

Undergrowth, short sagebrush and grass. No timber, grazing land.
