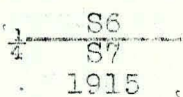

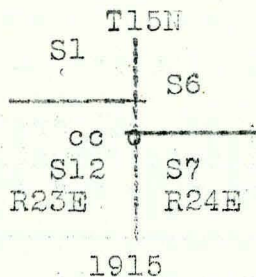

N. 89° 52' W., on a true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.
Over mountainous land, general face to the SE.
Ridge, 230 ft. above sec. cor., bears N. 20° E. and S.
20° W.; thence along land facing S.
275 ft. above sec. cor., on E. slope.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 16 ins. in
the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$
sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
