


Retracement and  
Resurvey of West Boundary T. 11 N., R. 27 E.


- Chains
- 41.00 Draw, course NW.; ascend 35 ft.
- 50.00 Top of W. slope of low hill, top of which bears E. 1 ch. Descend 130 ft.
- 67.50 Road, in main ravine, course NW.; the old road bears NW. and SE.
- 80.94 Thence gently ascend along nearly W. slope, 15 ft. to Fall 28 lks. E. of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a granite stone 6x10x16 ins. above ground, loosely set, properly marked, unwitnessed. I reestablish cor. as follows:  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground, alongside of stone for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.,

- and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.
- Course and distance of this ½ mile is N.0° 12' W., 40.70 chs.
- Land, mountainous, general N. and NW. exposure and drainage.
- Soil, rocky and gravelly, with some light sandy; 3rd. rate.
- Undergrowth, short greasewood and sheep brush.
- No timber.

- North, retracing and resurveying bet. secs. 1 and 6. Over rolling hilly land, facing SW.
- 7.20 Wash, 25 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.
- 21.50 Low saddle of ridge, bears E. and W., 25 ft. above sec. cor., thence descending over land, facing NE.
- 27.00 Head of draw, 35 ft. below ridge, course NE.; ascend 10 ft.
- 35.00 Top of ascent on E. slope, bears W.; descend 20 ft. to
- 40.71 Fall 16 lks. E. of the ¼ cor., which is a granite stone 8x8x10 ins. set in small mound of stone, properly marked I reestablish cor. as follows:  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, alongside of stone, marked for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



This is a ¼ corner for section 1 only.

- and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.
- Course and distance of this half mile is N:0°14'W., 40.71 chs.
- From my station 16 lks. E. of the ¼ cor. continue North. Descending NE. slope.
- 60.92 Road, Walker River to Walker Lake, bears N. 80°E. and S. 80°W.
- 66.30 Wide draw, 115 ft. below ¼ cor., course NW.; thence over nearly level land.
- 80.75 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course SW.
- 81.44 Fall 33 lks. E. of the cor. of Tps. 11 and 12 N1, Rs. 26 and 27 E. which is a quartz stone 6x9x18 ins., loosely set in mound of stone, properly marked, I reestablish cor. as follows:
