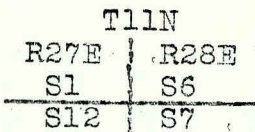

July 19: At 8h 6m a.m., l.mt., I set off 38° 45' on the lat. arc; 20° 59'N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. on E. bdy. of Tp., heretofore described.  
Thence  
West, on sectional correction line, bet. secs. 25 and 36  
Over rolling land, sloping W., through short undergrowth of sage and sheep brush, shadscale and some grass.  
Ravine, 10 ft. deep, course S. 80°W.  
Same ravine, course N. 80°W.  
215 ft. below sec. cor.
