


Subdivision of T. 11 N., R. 27 E.

Chains approximate 20 chs., near head of canyon.  
 Descend 190 ft.  
 57.50 Canyon, course N. 30°W.; ascend 60 ft.  
 62.80 Spur, projects NW.; descend 80 ft.  
 71.20 Ravine, course N. 10°W.; ascend NE. and N. slopes, 185 ft. to  
 84.50 Intersect W. bdy. of tp., 97 lks. N. 0°12'W. of cor. of secs. 12 and 13, heretofore described. At point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.,




and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high E. of corner.  
 Land, mountainous, general exposure and drainage to the N. Soil, rocky and gravelly, with some light sandy on surface; granite formation 3rd. and 4th rates. Undergrowth, short, sheep brush, greasewood and shadscale. No timber. Grazing land.

N. 0° 6'W. bet. secs. 7 and 8.  
 Over hilly land, facing N. and NW.  
 9.95 Ravine, 55 ft. below cor., course N. 30°W.; ascend 45 ft.  
 22.90 Spur, projects N. 30°W.; descend.  
 25.60 Head of ravine, course NW.  
 40.00 110 ft. below sec. cor.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,




and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.  
 80.00 155 ft. below ¼ sec. cor.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.  
 Land, low hilly, exposure and drainage to N. and NW. Soil, gravelly, stony and light sandy; undergrowth, short greasewood and bunch grass. No timber. Grazing land.  
 July 21: At the above cor., I set off 20°35'N. on the decl arc; and at apparent noon observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 38°48½'.

July 23: For solar see line bet. secs. 16 and 17.  
 East, on a random line bet. secs. 5 and 8.  
 40.00 Set temp. ¼ cor.

80.04 Intersect the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9. Thence West, on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 8.  
 Over rolling land, sloping northerly.  
 9.95 Ravine, 5 ft. deep, course NW.  
 21.10 Ravine, 5 ft. deep, course N. 30°W.  
 26.90 Low ridge, bears N. 30°W. and S. 30°E.  
 30.05 Ravine, 6 ft. deep, course N. 30°W.  
 40.02 110 ft. below sec cor., on N. slope.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
