

47.15 Main ravine, 15 ft. deep, course N. for 10 chs., thence NW.  
 56.40 Ravine, 5 ft. deep, course N. 10°W.  
 70.00 Ravine, 15 ft. deep, course N.  
 80.04 5 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.  
 Land, rolling, exposure and drainage to NW. and N.  
 Soil, gravelly, stony and light sandy, on gravel and hard, reddish clay subsoil; granite formation.  
 Undergrowth, short sheep brush, greasewood and bunch grass.  
 No timber. Grazing land.

July 21: For solar see line bet. secs. 7 and 18.  
 West, on random line bet. secs. 6 and 7.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 84.43 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp., 9 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, heretofore described. Thence S. 89° 56'E., on true line bet. secs. 6 and 7.  
 Over hilly land; ascend W. slope.  
 7.20 Head of small ravine, course NW.  
 12.50 Ridge and top of ascent, 100 ft. above sec. cor., bears N. 30°W. and S. 30°E.; descend 40 ft.  
 20.00 Ravine, course NW. for 1 ch., thence N.  
 36.30 Ravine, 10 ft. deep, course N.  
 44.43 145 ft. above sec. cor.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high N. of cor.

72.80 Ravine, 5 ft. deep, course NW.  
 84.43 25 ft. above  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,  
 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8.  
 Land, hilly and rolling, general exposure and drainage to N.  
 Soil, gravelly, stony and light sandy; granite formation;  
 Undergrowth, short sheep brush, greasewood, shadscale and bunch grass. No timber. Grazing land.


Knowing that a closing cor. is necessary on N. bdy. I run N. 0° 6'W. on a true line bet. secs. 5 and 6.  
 Over rolling land, sloping to the N. and NW.

40.00 80 ft. below sec. cor.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high W. of cor.

45.00 Wash, 40 lks. wide, 8 ft. deep, course NW.  
 81.91 60 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 Intersect the N. bdy. of Tp., 4.00 chs. S. 88° 15'E. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, heretofore described. At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high S. of cor.  
 Land, rolling, exposure and drainage to N. and NW.  
 Soil, coarse gravel and light sandy of decomposed granite, with scattering rocks.  
 Undergrowth, short sheep brush, greasewood, shadscale and bunch grass. No timber. Grazing land.
