Chains

From the reestablished cor. of Tps. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 31 and 32 E., I run East, retracing bet. secs. 6 and 31. At 39.40 chs., after careful search no trace of  $\frac{1}{4}$  cor. At 80.29 chs., fall 1 lk. S. of the sec. cor. which I find to be a post 1x2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. by 18 ins. long, set in the ground, properly marked but very dim. Therefore I return to tp. cor. Thence East, resurveying bet. secs. 6 and 31, on N. bdy. of tp. Telephone line, from Fallon to Fairview and Wonder, bears N. 65°W. and S. 65°E. Main road, (Lincoln Highway) from Fallon to Wonder and Fairview, bears N. 62°W. and S. 62°E. Proportional point for reestablished  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in in dia., 26 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

Dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., in each sec. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor. Land, level flat.

Soil, muddy clay with some fine wet sand; 4th rate. No vegetation. Elevation 3961 ft. above sea level. Aug. 7, 1915.

Aug. 11, At 8h 5m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39° 16' on the lat. arc; 15° 29' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32 on N. bdy. of tp. as reestablished by me Aug. 7.

Thence

East, on a random line for dist. only, along the N. bdy. of tp. T. 16 N., R. 32 E.; setting temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. and sec. cors. at intervals of 40.00 chs.

At temp. cor. secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.

Aug. 11, 1915

Aug. 12: At 8h 35m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 39° 16' on the lat. arc; 15° 11' N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian at the above temp. cor.; thence continue East on N. bdy. of tp.

At 400.00 chs. set temp. cor. for Ts. 16 and 17 N., Rs. 32 and 33 E.

On Aug. 25: the permanent tp. cor. was set on E. bdy. at a point 11 lks. E. of temp. cor.
