GENERAL DESCRIPTION.

The two secs. surveyed in this tp., contains a level alkali and salt flat in the greater portion of sec. 31, and gentle rolling lands in remainder, having a slight slope to the SW.; the soil is a light sandy loam, in the southern part of sec. 32, while in the northern it is a deep, loose, fine, white sand.

In the SW. quarter of sec. 32, are 2 wells. In the vicinity of which heavy salt grass is found. Water is had at a depth of from 10 to 20 ft.

To the north of cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, is a sand mountain, rising several hundred feet above surrounding land of pure white sand. There are no settlers in the tp.

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
