80.04 Fall 19 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10. Thence
S. 89° 58'W. on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 9.
Over rolling mountainous land, facing to the S.,
through scattering pinon pine and cedar.
1.00 Low flat ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend 80 ft.
11.35 Small draw, course S. for 5 chs. thence SE.; ascend
