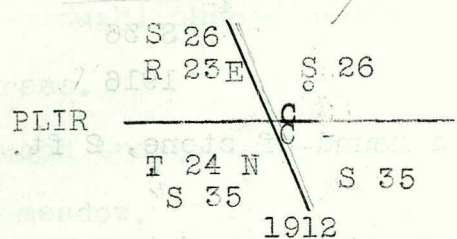


Fractional Subdivision, T. 24 N, R. 23 E .

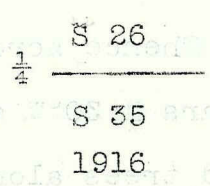
Chains N 89° 53' W on a random line bet. secs. 26 and 35  
 40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.  
 58.24 Fall 9 lks. S. of the closing cor. of fractional secs. 26 and 35 : this corner is an iron post, firmly set in the ground ,of the dimensions, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

i change the markings to



dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec. 5 1/2 ft. dist.  
 Thence S. 89° 48' E, on a true line bet. secs. 26 and 35  
 Over rolling, sandy land.

18.24 40 ft. below closing sec. cor.  
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia. 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.



dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist.  
 Continue gradual descent.

44.08 Cross large bunch of coral rocks.  
 58.24 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36; 80 ft. below 1/4 sec. cor.  
 Land, rolling, sandy, gentle slope to the N.E.  
 Soil, medium texture, sandy loam, very dry. 1st. and 2nd. rate. Poor feed of sage brush and some grass.  
 No timber.

S 89° 53' E on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36

40.00 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.  
 79.95 Fall 7 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36  
 Thence N 89° 56' W on a true line bet. secs. 25 and 36  
 Over somewhat undulating, sandy land.  
 3.60 Road, bears N 10° W and S 10° E  
 11.45 Low ridge, bears S 15° W and N 25° E. 15 ft. below sec. cor.
