on the bdy. line of the Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation.

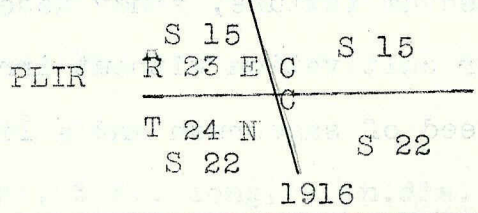
Thence N 89° 55' W, toward it, bet. secs. 15 and 22
