

## Retracement of fractional N. bdy. of T 21 N, R 29 E.

Chains	From the cor. of secs. 4,5,32 and 33; on the N. bdy. of the tp., the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. bet. secs. 4 and 33 is plainly visible on a course of N 88°47'E. Retrace N 88°47'E bet. secs. 4 and 33.
38.68	The old $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., which is a cottonwood stake, 2 x 2 ins. by 2 ft. above ground, firmly set in the ground and mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ on the N. face. From the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. Retrace N 89°56'E, bet. secs. 4 and 33.
40.03	No old cor. for secs. 3,4,33 and 34. Set temp. cor for secs. 3,4,33 and 34 .
	From temp. cor. of secs. 3,4,33 and 34. Retrace N 89°56'E, bet. secs. 3 and 34.
40.03	Intersect the old $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor., a cottonwood stake, 2 x 2 ins. by 18 ins. above ground, firmly set in the ground and mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ on the N. face.
45.00	Intersect the shore of the Lower Carson lake.
