

Survey of fractional E. bdy. T 21 N, R 29 E.


Chains

Begin at the meander corner of sec. 18, on the E. bdy. of the tp., this cor. is N., 11.40 chs. from the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24; on the E. bdy. of the tp. N. bet. secs. 13 and 18

Over level land, sloping slightly to the N.E.

15.30 Wagon road, bears N 55°W and S 55°E


28.60 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. dia. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.



dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist.

68.60 Intersect the edge of Lower Carson Lake

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. dia., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18; and for meander corner on Lower Carson Lake; with brass cap mkd.



dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec., 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.

Land, level land, with slight slope to the N.E. on the border of Lower Carson Lake.

Soil, fine texture, adobe soil, highly impregnated with mineral salts; unfit for cultivation.

Vegetation consists of weeds.
