- A pinon pine, 10 ins. in dia., bears N. 66° 20'E., 16 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 32 B T
 A pinon pine, 12 ins. in dia., bears S. 24°E., 29 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 B T
 Corner stands in head of ravine, 60 ft. below top of spur, which drains N.
 Ascend.
 53.00 Top of ridge, 155ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ cor., bears NW. and SE.
 Descend.
 30.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 8 ins. in the ground to solid rock and raise a mound of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, around post for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, with brass cap marked

 A pinon pine, 10 ins. in dia., bears N. 0° 35'W., 1.63 chs. dist., marked T 8 N R 49 E S 31 B T
 Corner stands on W. slope of ridge, 595 ft. below the top.
 Land, mountainous with general drainage and exposure to the N.; soil, stony on surface; 4th rate; timber, dense growth of cedars and pinon pine; scattering undergrowth of sage brush, mountain rush, juniper, buck brush and grass; fair grazing, 80 chs.
 July 28: At this cor. I set off 19° 04'N., on decl. arc and at 12h 06 m l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian the resulting lat. is 38° 29'.

West, along S. bdy. of Tp., between secs. 6 and 31. Over mountainous land through dense growth of cedars and pinon pine and scattering undergrowth of sage brush, mountain rush, juniper, buck brush and grass.
