

Subdivision of T.11N., R.60 E.

Chains

Over mountainous land through scattering growth of cedars and pinon pine and scattering undergrowth of black sage, mountain rush, juniper and bunch grass.

Descend.

8.00 Top of trachyte ledge, 60 ft. high, brs. N.70°E. and S.70° W.

25.10 Bottom of hollow, 230 ft. below sec. cor., drs. NE.

Ascend gently.

Leave mountainous land; enter rolling hills, brs. NE. and SW.

34.50 Top of spur, 30 ft. above bottom of hollow, projects N.20° E., about 20 chs.

Descend.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked

S3 1/4 S2

1914 from which

A cedar, 7 ins. dia., bears S.71° 40'E., 45 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 2 B T.

A cedar, 7 ins. dia., bears S.33°W., 84 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 3 B T.

10 ft. below top of spur.

45.00 Bottom of hollow, 20 ft. below 1/4 cor., drs. N.20°E.

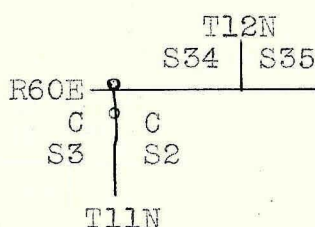
Ascend.

66.50 Top of spur, 20 ft. above bottom of hollow, projects N. 30°E.

Descend.

76.46 Intersect N. bdy. of the TP., 2.92 chs. N.87°51'W. of the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, heretofore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked
