

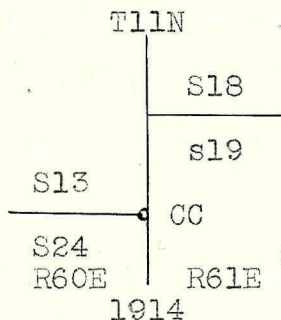

Chains

Ascend.

79.65 Intersect E. bdy. of the Tp., 1.40 chs. S.0°41'W. of the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, heretofore described.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 13 and 24 with brass cap marked



No bearing trees available; erect a mound of stone, 3½ ft. base, 2½ ft. high, W. of cor.

100 ft. above bottom of hollow.

Land, mountainous of limestone formation; general drainage and exposure to the NE. on W. 27½ chs.; to SW on 10 chs.; to SE on 15 chs.; and to SW. on E. 27 chs.; soil, stony on surface; 4th rate; timber, scattering growth of cedars and pinon pine; scattering undergrowth of black sage, shadscale, mountain rush, juniper, buck brush and bunch grass; fair grazing, 79½ chs.

N.0° 03'E., bet. secs. 13, and 14.

Over mountainous land through scattering growth of cedars and pinon pine and scattering undergrowth of black sage, shadscale, mountain rush, juniper, buck brush and bunch grass.

3.70 Bottom of draw, 100 ff. below sec. cor., drs. NE.

Ascend.

12.70 Top of spur, 70 ft. above draw, projects S.80°E.

Descend.

33.00 Dry wash, 1 ch. wide, 8 ft. deep, in bottom of hollow, 220 ft. below top of spur, drs. SE.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
