


Subdivision of T.5 S., R.66 E.

Chains
 14.50 East side of Meadow Valley wash, bears N.20°W. and S.25° E.
 15.32 From this point, point "A" bears S.77° 30'E., 8.22 chs. dist., and from point "A" The SE. cor. of T.C. Tennille's house, bears N.19° 20'E., 3.07 chs. dist.
 The NW. cor. of T.C. Tennille's chicken house, bears N. 64° 50'E., 3.00 chs. dist.
 The NW. cor. of T.C. Tennille's wagon shed, bears N.67°E., 1.02 chs. dist.
 The NW. cor. of T.C. Tennille's barn, bears S.83° 43'E., 1.96 chs. dist.
 The NW. cor. of T.C. Tennille's cow shed, bears S.66° 55'E., 1.45 chs. dist.
 The NE. cor. of T.C. Tennille's cellar, bears S.46° 35'W., 4.45 chs. dist.
 31.02 East side of Meadow Valley wash, bears NE. and S.25°W.
 32.20 Creek, 20 lks. wide, 6 to 10 ins. deep, drains S.25°W.
 32.55 West side of Meadow Valley wash, bears NE. and S.25°W.
 -40.11 Intersect the First Standard Parallel South, 20.72 chs. west of the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, heretofore described.
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap marked



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and raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

The land along this line is nearly level bottom land, with a slight general drainage, southerly; soil, light brown sandy pliable and damp loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep, with some scattering loose boulders on surface; no timber; medium undergrowth of sun flower
