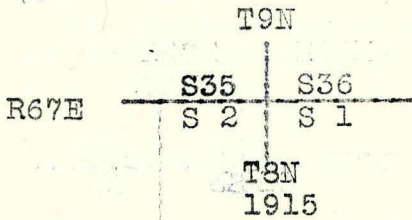


6. South Boundary T. 9 N., R. 67 E.

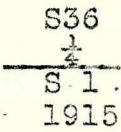
Chains

A Pinon pine, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 19° 50'E., 60 lks dist., mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T
A Pinon pine, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 25° 50'W., 1.00 ch. dist., mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 35 B T
Corner stands on E. slope of spur 210 ft. below top.
50.00 Bottom of descent and foot of mountains, 170 ft. below $\frac{1}{4}$ corner.
Enter rolling land, bears N. and S.
Timber becomes scattering; undergrowth, medium, bears N. and S.
80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.,

A Cedar, 10 ins. diam. bears N. 64°E., 1.08 chs. dist., mkd. T 9 N R 67 E S 36 B T
Cedar, 7 ins. in diam., bears S. 25° 15'E., 1.82 chs. dist. mkd. T 8 N R 67 E S 1 B T
A Cedar, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 20°40'W., 1.05 chs. dist., mkd. T 8 N R 67 E S 2 B T
A Cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 71° 30'W., 1.33 chs. dist., mkd. T 9 N R 67 E S 35 B T
Land, mountainous of limestone formation on W. 50 chs.; rolling on E. 30 chs.; general exposure and drainage of the mile, to the E.; soil, 4th. rate; very stony on surface, W. 50 chs. sandy gravelly stiff loam of hard texture, 26 ins. deep on E. 30 chs.; dense cedars and pinon on W. 50 chs; scattering same on E. 30 chs.; scant scattering sage brush and grass on W. 50 chs.; medium same on E. 30 chs.; scant grazing 80 chs.
June 29: I set off 23° 16'N. on the decl. arc; and at 12h. 03m., p.m. l.m.t., I observe the sun on ther meridian the resulting latitude is 38° 35'.

East bet. secs. 1 and 36.
Rolling land, scattering cedars and pinon pine, medium sage brush, greasewood, rabbit brush and scattering grass.
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
