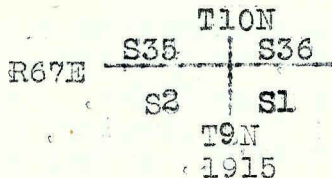

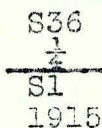
and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, with brass cap mkd.,



Dig pits, 18x18x12ins. in each sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of cor. Land, gently rolling with general drainage to N.E.; soil, sandy clay gravelly loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep, no timber; medium black and white sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood and scattering grass; fair grazing, 80 chs.

S. $89^{\circ}58'E.$, bet. secs. 1 and 36. Gently rolling land, medium sage brush, shadscale, greasewood and scattering grass.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Dig pits, 18x18x12ins. E. and W. of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.
Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep, course N. E.
Intersect the cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 N., Rs. 67 and 68 E., heretofore described.
Land, gently rolling with general drainage to N.E.; soil, sandy clay gravelly loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep, no timber; medium sage brush, shadscale, greasewood and scattering grass; scant grazing, 80 chs.
