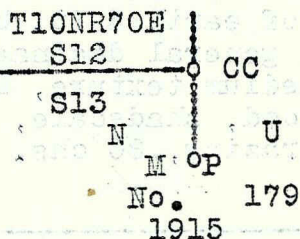

Subdivision of T. 10 N., R. 70 E.

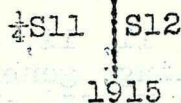
Chains

of corner.
 June 14: I set off $23^{\circ} 15' N.$, on the decl. arc; and at 12h 00m l.m.t., I observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is $38^{\circ} 43'$.
 68.50 Wagon road, bears N. $20^{\circ} E.$ and S. $20^{\circ} W.$
 80.00 From this point
 The N. E. cor. of T.C. Robert's house bears S. $60^{\circ} 15' W.$
 158.88 Intersect Nevada Utah State line, 19.36 chs. N. of Mile Post No. 179 heretofore described.
 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for Closing Corner of secs. 12 and 13, T. 10 N., R. 70 E., with brass cap mkd.,



Dig pits, $30 \times 24 \times 12$ ins. crosswise on each line, N. and S. 3 ft., and W. of post, 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of corner.
 Land, rolling; general drainage to N. and N.E.; soil, sandy clay loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep; no timber; medium greasewood, shadscale, rabbit brush, sage brush and scattering grass; scant grazing 159 chs.
 June 14, 1915.

June 15, 1915: At 7h.30m.a.m., l.m.t., I set off $38^{\circ} 43' N.$ on the lat. arc; $23^{\circ} 18' N.$ on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14.
 Thence I run
 N. $0^{\circ} 03' E.$ bet. secs. 11 and 12.
 Rolling land, medium greasewood, shadscale, rabbit brush, sage brush and grass.
 15.50 Big Springs Creek, 15 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course N.E.
 19.50 Wagon road, Big Springs to Garrison, bears N.E. and S.W.
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



Dig pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner.
 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, with brass cap mkd.,



Dig pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., in each sec. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high W. of corner.
 Land, rolling with general drainage to N. E. on S. $15\frac{1}{2}$ chs.; to S. E. on N. $64\frac{1}{2}$ chs.; soil, sandy clay loam of medium texture, 26 ins. deep; no timber; medium greasewood, shadscale, rabbit brush, sage brush and
