Chains

S.  $89^{\circ} 55' W.$  on a true line, bet. secs. 4 and 9.  
 Over rolling mountainous land. Ascend 5 ft. on NE. slope.  
 1.00 Top of ascent; descend 80 ft. on NW. slope.  
 23.00 Foot of descent; ascend 45 ft. on NE. slope to top of  
 ridge.  
 35.00 Ridge, bears N.  $15^{\circ} W.$  and S.  $15^{\circ} E.$ ; descend 100 ft. on  
 SW. slope to sec. cor.  
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 15 ins. in  
 the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for  $\frac{1}{4}$   
 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

 80.00 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  
 Land, rolling mountains. Soil, stony and rocky. Sparse  
 sagebrush. Good grass. No timber.  
 Traveling at noon, therefore it was impossible to take  
 observation for latitude.

September 2, 1915.

August 20: From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9 I run  
 N.  $0^{\circ} 3' W.$  bet. secs. 4 and 5.  
 Over rolling mountainous land. Ascend slightly on SW.  
 slope.  
 2.00 Top of ascent; descend 60 ft. on NW. slope to C.C.  
 14.41 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 43 N., R. 24 E., at a point  
 16.51 chs. N.  $89^{\circ} 19' W.$  of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on S. bdy.  
 sec. 33, and at point of intersection set an iron post  
 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for  
 Closing Corner of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd.,

 18.35 Stone house bears N.  $27^{\circ} W.$  and Beebe's house bears N.  $24^{\circ}$   
 W.  
 28.00 Draw, course N.  $75^{\circ} W.$   
 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in  
 the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
