N. $0^{\circ} 2' W.$, on a random line, for distance only bet. secs. 2 and 3.
 40.00 Set a temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. referring to sec. 2 and 3.
 120.46 Intersect the Nevada-Oregon State Line at a point 21.88 chs. S. $89^{\circ} 32' W.$ of the 221 mile cor. hereinbefore described, and at point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for Closing Corner of secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd.,

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of corner.

At this cor. I set off $19^{\circ} 6' S.$ on the decl. arc and at about 11h 45m a.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is $42^{\circ} 0'$.

Thence I run

S. $0^{\circ} 2' E.$ on a true line, bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Over mountainous land. Ascend 590 ft. on NE. slope to top of ridge.

9.00 Short draw, course NE.

42.50 Ridge, bears NW. and SE., descend 90 ft. on SW. slope to draw.

56.00 Draw, near head, course N. $80^{\circ} W.$; ascend 165 ft. on NW. slope to top of ridge.

72.50 Ridge, bears N. $70^{\circ} W.$ and S. $70^{\circ} E.$ descend 175 ft. on SW. slope to ravine.

80.46 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 23 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. referring to secs 2, and 3, with brass cap mkd.;

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of corner.

S. $0^{\circ} 02' E.$ from the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, by W. E. Hoffman on Nov. 18, 1915, and marked the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. set on the same date referring to sec. 2 only, at 80.46 chs. S. $0^{\circ} 02' E.$ from the closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, so as to refer to both secs. 2 and 3 as shown above, moved mound of stone from E. to W. side of cor.
